References

Obtain two (2) letters of recommendation. One recommendation must be school-related and one recommendation must be either community-related or church-related.

Counselor Verification

Complete and sign the top portion in black or blue ink before submitting to your counselor.

Acknowledgement and Selection

Due to the significant number of exceptional scholarship applications received every year, it is not possible to acknowledge receipt of applications or notify recipients who are not selected to receive a scholarship. Scholarship recipients will be selected and notified by the end of April.

Finalists will be contacted to schedule an interview in person or via Skype or Face Time.
